The tenth annual Boca Grande Invitational was played on three Gasparilla Inn courts. There was a full house of twenty-four players divided into three flights; the courts were in splendid shape. The final game was the game to watch, with the major plays being a multi wicket run by Dale to end with his yellow ball to the peg. Alan then commenced a similar run taking his blue ball to the peg, but also picking up the yellow ball along the way and pegging out the opponent ball. Dale stayed off the probable loss with several long hit-ins, but ultimately his luck and skill lost out to Alan's competitive advantage Alan took the match and the title 22 to 20 in a thrilling match.

Championship "B" with handicaps 4 to 5, also consisted of eight players, Sheila Davis the lone local representative, but included six players from the Sarasota County Croquet Club, located locally in Venice, Florida. Glenn Bennett and Ralph Moore were #1 and #2 at the end of block play on Saturday. Sunday saw the same ladder arrangement, as the other two blocks, with #3 seed Jack Montgomery taking out Roni Brazell, then Ralph Moore, and finally Glenn Bennett to win the flight 15-13. Sheila Davis tied with Ralph Moore for third place.

First flight with eight players, handicaps 5 to 10, and three players were from Venice, and three players from Oyster Bay, New York. In a contest between the two cities, the two left to play off the finals were John Postley from NY, and Jim McLaughlin who winters in Venice, but hails from New Hampshire. John Postley won over Jim 16-10 to take the trophy. John and Elaine Postley and Ann Nolte, commented, as they have in previous years that the stay at the Gasparilla Inn is a strong attraction to entice them to return year after year to compete in this tournament

As usual, the hosts, Gasparilla Mallet Club and the Boca Bay Croquet Club, wined and dined the participants throughout the three-day tournament. An opening party courtside on Thursday set the stage.
